INSTRUCTIONS:

1) The application for an Absentee Ballot must include the registered voter's name, address of voting residence, applicant's date of birth, and signature, AND must also include one of the following:

- the applicant's Ohio driver's license number;
- the last four digits of the applicant's Social Security Number;
- an attached COPY of some form of valid photo identification belonging to the applicant or an attached COPY of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or some other government document showing the applicant's name and address.

2) An application by mail/fax must be received by the Board of Elections by noon on the 3rd day before the election.

Applications by the voter in person may be received until the close of regular board hours the day before the election. Application for persons who are hospitalized by medical emergency will be accepted until 3 pm on election day.

3) Voted ballots must be returned to the Board of Elections by 7:30 pm on election day. Exception: if the voter is outside the US on election day, the ballot envelope must be signed or postmarked prior to the close of polls and received by the Board no later than 10 days after the election or 20 days after a presidential primary election. The Identification Envelope must be properly completed and signed prior to returning the ballot.
